Requirement of qualification in GATE / National Exam is waived for the following categories of applicants:

- I. Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs) pursuing B.Tech./B.E./ Integrated M. Tech/ Integrated M. Sc. programmes (or any other programme of minimum four year duration, admission to which is on the basis of JEE), who have completed 6 semesters or more, and have CGPA of 8.000 or above (on a 10 point scale). Such students must obtain a CGPA of 8.000 or above at the time of graduation, and before they formally register for the Ph.D. programme (80% aggreGATE marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation);
- II. Graduates of CFTIs (in the programmes marked under (i)) with a final graduation CGPA of more than 8.000 (80% aggreGATE marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation);
- III. M.A or M.Sc. graduates from IITs with CGPA 8.000 or above.
